## MIRAGE ECLIPSE TRADE INSTRUCTIONS

## ROUGH OPENINGS:

- All rough openings must be framed 2 ¾" wider and 2" higher then finished floor according to door schedule. (Allows for 3/8" undercut)
- Example a 3'0" x 8'0" rough opening should be framed at exactly 38 ¾" x 98" from finished floor.
- NOTE: Eclipse Series single swing door cannot exceed 3'0" in width and 8'0" in height.

## • FLAWLESS FLUSH DOOR:

- Dorr Houzzer highly recommends that all door openings should have the floor track running through the opening to guarantee that both legs will sit flush with the wall.
- 18 gauge studs should then be installed at all Mirage Frame openings. If 18-gauge studs are not used at rough opening make sure there is enough bracing so that the frame will not move once secured in place.
- NOTE: If track does not run through opening be sure that both jamb legs line up. Otherwise we cannot guarantee a *flawless flush door*.

## DRYWALL COMPOUND:

- All frames need to be wiped clean and applied with bonding agent.
- Once bonding agent has dried, apply paper tape over the frame and drywall joint.
- o Apply 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> coasts as necessary and sand.
- NOTE: If drywall finisher does not abide by our cleaning and finishing instructions the *drywall compound* applied to the Mirage Frame may *crack*.
